


Effective reproduction or R is an estimate of the average number of new infections caused by a single infected individual. When R is greater than 1, the number of new infections will increase.




Reported Vaccinations by Patient County



Below is the number of COVID-19 patients currently hospitalized (dark blue), and of those hospitalized who are in the ICU (green) and are using ventilators (light blue). The grey bar represents the number of patients per reporting hospital, a rate that can help us better interpret changes in COVID-19 hospitalizations (as not all hospitals report each day).

The total number of COVID-19 positive patients hospitalized across TN on September 02, 2021 was 3,685. There are 997 COVID-19 patients currently in the ICU and 721 utilizing ventilators. The number of admitted patients per hospital reporting was 29.02 (with 114 hospitals reporting).





