

Draft Land Development Ordinance Ready for Review

The initial draft of a growth-guiding Land Development Ordinance (LDO) for Thompson's Station is now available for community review.

Those who participated in well-attended workshop sessions last spring will see lots of familiar ideas. So take a bow for all your hard work.

Here's what happens next:

The LDO draft goes through the usual public review processes until a final version goes before the Board of Mayor and Alderman (BOMA). First steps in that process get underway next week with joint work sessions by the BOMA and the Town's Planning Commission.

The first of the two sessions will be on Wednesday, August 5, at 5:30 p.m. at the Community Center, 1555 Thompson's Station Road West. The second will be on the following day, Thursday, August 6, also at 5:30 p.m. at the Tennessee Equine Hospital, 1508 Thompson's Station Road West.

Both meetings are open to the public.
